In September 2006 the DuPage Emergency Telephone System Board signed a contract with Motorola to design and build a private 700MHz county-wide digital trunked radio system that would be connected to the STARCOM 21 system. Good progress was made with site engineering, coverage, and Region 54 approved a frequency application last October. The projected high cost of future maintenance, down turn of the economy, continued loss of landline surcharge revenue and a possible sunset of the wireless surcharge in 2013, caused the DuPage ETSB to investigate alternatives to the private 700MHz county-wide digital trunked radio system. Working with Motorola, DuPage County ETSB has identified The Proposed DuPage County STARCOM 21 Subsystem Alternative using the State of Illinois STARCOM 21 platform similar to the model used in St. Clair County.

This change of project scope will have an impact on the project schedule. The current projected timeline provides a transition to the new system in early 2011. The timeline for subscriber unit (radios) purchase is in late September 2010. If we were to purchase the subscriber units to meet the current July 2010 deadline, these units would remain warehoused until templates were designed and programming started in October 2010. Shipment of subscriber units starts the warranty period and has a financial impact on extended warranties.

The addition of 4 new sites to the STARCOM 21 infrastructure will push the schedule beyond July 2010. In addition the Region 54 application will need to be revised to reflect the Proposed DuPage County STARCOM 21 Subsystem Alternative. Region 54 approval is anticipated in October 2010.

Due to these circumstances, DuPage ETSB is requesting an extension to the PSIC grant project completion date to July 2011. Attached is revised PSIC grant application and attachments schedule A and B.
